Did you know?


People have 3 types of teeth.

These teeth have adapted because of the kinds of foods that we eat.

Animals like dogs and cats have well developed canines.

Horses rely on their molars and don't even have canines!

What to do: (Look at the picture)
incisors:
Count all the incisors. There are 8 incisors
Colour them
<u>canines:</u>
Count all the canines. There are 4 canines.
Colour them
<u>premolars:</u>
Count all the premolars. There are <u>8</u> premolars
Colour them
molars:
Count all the molars. There are <u>12_</u> molars
